Vassar Student Association Amendment An Amendment Clarifying the Student Life Position Principal Authors: Raymond and Student Life

SECTION 1: Let Article V, Section 2, Clause D of the VSA Constitution be amended to read: D. The Vice President for Student Life (VP for Student Life) shall work to improve the quality of student life and promote general student welfare at Vassar College.

SECTION 2: Let Article I, Section 2 of the VSA Bylaws be amended as follows:

SECTION 2: POWERS AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE VP FOR STUDENT LIFE

- A. Serve as primary liaison to the Dean of the College Division, including Campus Life and Diversity and its centers.
- B. Provide support and guidance for House Teams and the Board of House Presidents.; including coordinating House Officer training.
- C. Represent the unique set of issues faced by students associated with Campus Life and Diversity and its centers.

SECTION 3: Let Article III, Section 2 of the VSA bylaws be amended as follows:

SECTION 2: STUDENT LIFE COMMITTEE

The Student Life Committee shall:

- A. Be chaired by the VP for Student Life, and membership shall be open to all members of the VSA.
- B. Consider issues pertaining to the quality of student life and relevant administrative offices.
- C. Consider issues of campus climate, including those brought forth by students, organizations, or the Campus Life and Diversity office.

ENACTMENT: As is prescribed in Article XII, Section 1 of the Constitution, this amendment shall be enacted by a two-thirds majority vote of the VSA Council. The VSA Governing Documents shall be shifted accordingly to reflect these changes.
